Vivek Chetana was blessed at the very outset as an organization by Sri Sarada Math and Ramakrishna Sarada Mission. For the last thirty-nine years they have shown us the path of service in the light of ideals propounded by Swamiji. Emboldened by the strength of his message and the depth of his vision we dared to take up more and more challenges in order to reach out to physically challenged, economically disadvantaged and marginalized women and children in urban and rural localities. Health, nutrition, hygiene and education were our main areas of focus. Then, extending our reach to facilitate women's need for self – reliance, we are now actively pursuing vocational – training courses for aspiring young adult women and enterprising mothers. Our supplementary coaching programmes for school going children in villages like Gobindapur, Bardeuli and Gangarampur adopt a holistic approach, in that we include arts, music, health and hygiene in our curriculum.

KAAJER KAGOJ

This is a self-help project for severely orthopaedically disabled and economically disadvantaged women. We held a grand pre-puja in-house exhibition of Step Together products in September 2023, which evoked a very appreciative response. Staff members of Step Together accompanied by some members of Vivek Chetana went for a day out programme to Deulti in February 2024.

MELA

UDAYAN

This centre at Bardeuli organizes supplementary coaching and has been in operation for seven years. The children's enthusiasm, hard-working teachers, support of all the coordinators and residents sustained this project and the students now number sixty, enrolled in classes KG to Class IV.

Teachers hold classes in art, music besides teaching subjects in the syllabi. Independence Day 2023 was a festive event, celebrated with a drawing competition, flag – hoisting and community activities. Much awaited prizes were awarded to the talented winners of the drawing competition in the month of March. Saraswati Puja was celebrated by the students, teachers and members of the local community.

In February 2024, Vivek Chetana organized a magic show at the village. It was a huge draw among both children and their guardians. Students received food packets after the show. Members visiting from Kolkata were pleased to meet some past pupils of Udayan. Among them was Rimi Khatoon, who belonged to the first batch and who passed the Madhyamik Examination in 2024. The care, expertise and commitment shown by their teachers have made the students of Udayan equally proficient in academics, arts and music.

A hugely successful health camp was organized here at Bardeuli in March, 2024. Dr. Madhumita Kumar, our patron and well-wisher, examined the health of over sixty children of Udayan, that of their mothers as well as of the ladies of Project Nabadisha. Besides examination Dr. Kumar spoke to

the ladies on matters of hygiene and general health. Vivek Chetana appreciates the time and effort spared by Dr. Kumar and expresses deep gratitude.

Smt. Chandrima Dutta Gupta distributed water bottles and tiffin boxes. Drawing books and crayons were distributed by Smt. Nilanjana Nundee and Food packets were distributed by Smt. Mahuya Mukherjee.

Smt. Pragna Mandal sponsored a picnic for the children and teachers.

SOLAR INSTALLATION

In August 2023, Vivek Chetana completed the installation of Solar apparatus in this village of Bardeuli. Lack of power connection was making it difficult for teachers and students of Udayan and Nabadisha to conduct and attend classes. UTTARAN

Project Uttaran, the coaching unit for students of Classes IX and X is running successfully at Gangarampore.

In June 2023, under the guidance of their teachers and members of Vivek Chetana, Uttaran students exhibited science models they had created. One model depicted the transformation of wind energy through windmill which could power street lighting. Yet another model displayed the process of distillation.

In April 2023 Spriha Society (NGO) in collaboration with Vivek Chetana conducted a health awareness session for over eighty five young girls and young mothers at Gangarampur. The session was organised for the beneficiaries of our Uttaran, Disha and Nabadisha projects. This was followed by distribution of sanitary napkins to the beneficiaries.

An essay competition was held to celebrate Independence Day. Prizes were awarded to Swastika Singh, Monika Mondal and Anneysa Pramanick.

AARTA SAHAY

Vivek Chetana has always been conscious of the need of upholding the dignity as well as of providing some additional support to lonely, deprived, elderly women. In 2019, the Aarta Sahay project was launched for elderly women living in and around Gangarampur village, with funds donated by several sympathetic sponsors. Every month, through volunteers, Vivek Chetana distributes hampers containing items of regular use - like snacks, soap, puffed rice, seasonal fruits, sugar and detergent powder, for their convenience. Swamiji's message of inclusion and service to the hapless members of our society

inspires us as much as this small measure of consolation to them. In 2019, the project began with only a handful of women, now accommodates twenty five grateful respondents.

Another fact worthy of mention is that Aarta Sahay project beneficiaries received several 'gifts' throughout the year. The products were items of daily necessities as also eatables. In April, 2023, floor mats were donated by Sm. Aparajita Nag and her family. Debjani Bhattacharyya donated plastic buckets mugs and stools in June 2023. In August, 2023, Sri Ravi Balasubramaniam gifted bed sheets with pillow covers. Sm. Esha Mukherjee donated slippers, socks and head coverings in December 2023. In January 2024, chaddars were distributed by Sm. Pragna Mondal. Food packets were distributed by Smt. Anuva Putatunda in the month of August 2023.

Swamiji wanted the disadvantaged section of society not to be dependent on donation, but to become self-reliant and build a stronger India.

Shailee is our introductory scheme at Gobindopur to arrange income – oriented courses for skill – development. Some of our past students are eager to join such training courses. The current beauticians course is our first attempt in this direction. It has generated a lot of interest among participants. Sri Aniruddha Kundu has very generously sponsored the first batch of trainees. The session started in February and continued for six weeks.

Efforts are on to admit and sponsor a limited number of deserving candidates to nearby institutions for a para – nursing course. We welcome donations for this purpose.

Vivek Chetana is keen to explore other such options for women of Gangarampur and Bardeuli, as much as our donations and funds permit.
